"You have washed us with your blood; you are worthy, Lamb of God!"

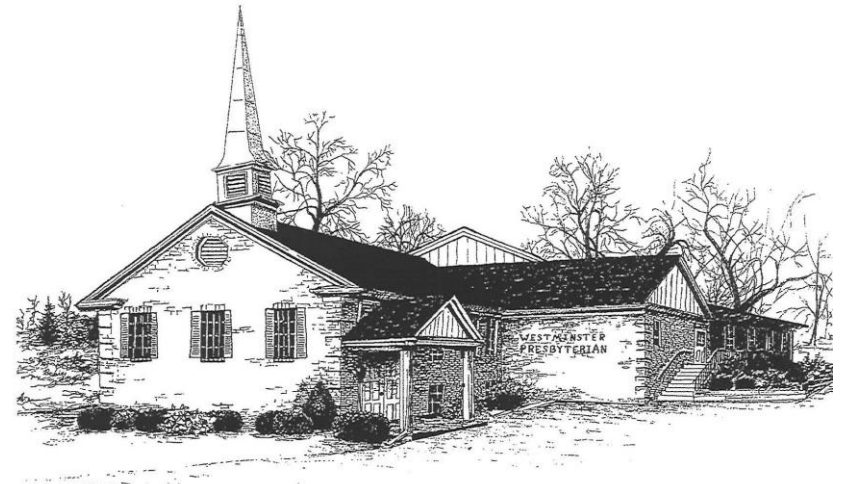
