to thy glorious rest above.

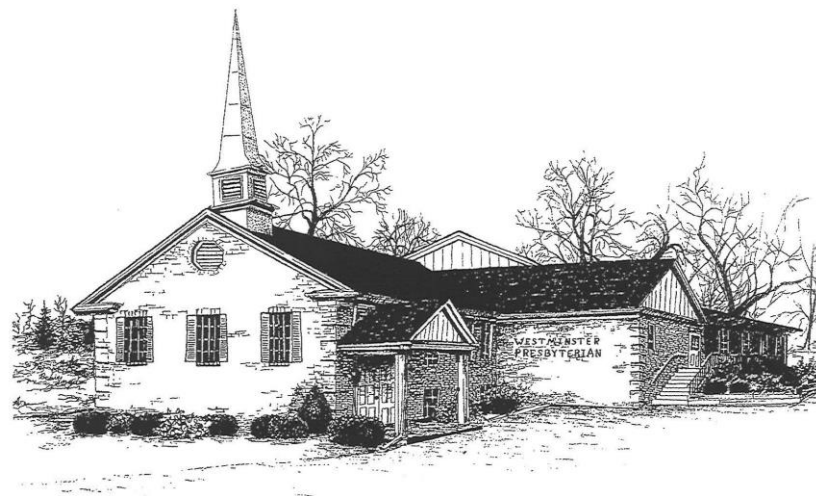
O the deep, deep love of Jesus!
