"nor let that ransomed sinner die!"


My God is reconciled; his pard'ning voice I hear;

Leader: Are we to pray unto God only?

People: God only being able to search the hearts, hear the requests, pardon the sins, and fulfil the desire of all; and only to be believed in, and worshipped with religious worship; prayer, which is a special part thereof, is to be made by all to Him alone, and to none other.

Leader: What is it to pray in the name of Christ?

People: To pray in the name of Christ is, in obedience to His command, and in confidence on His promises, to ask mercy for His sake; not by bare mentioning of His name, but by drawing our encouragement to pray, and our boldness, strength, and hope of acceptance in prayer, from Christ and His mediation.
