Session Meeting – Please pray for our session as they meet this *Thursday, October 7th* at **6:30 p.m.**

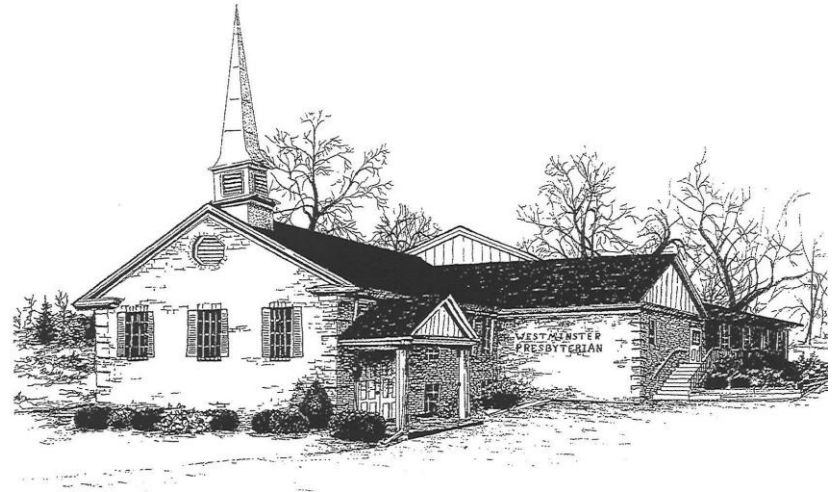
