Thank Offering – November is Thank Offering month. Please use the envelopes provided in the pew racks and prayerfully consider how you might give.

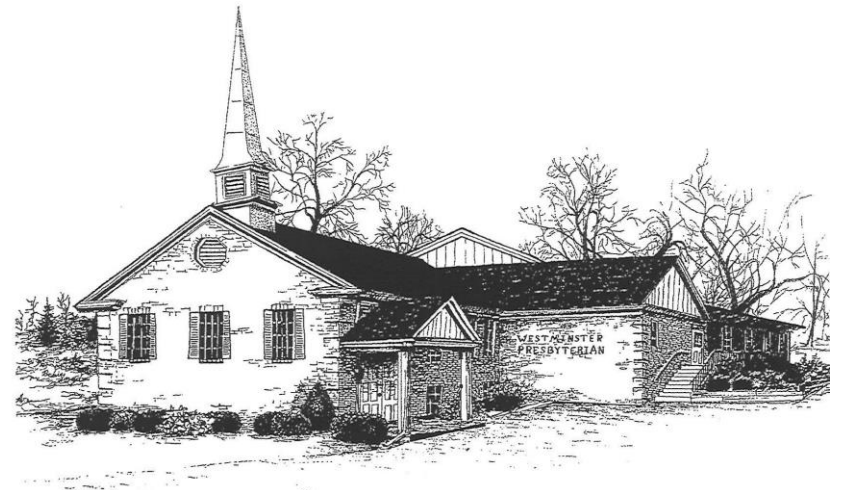
Housing and Vehicle Needed – One of our member's family members is looking for housing and a used vehicle. Please see either bulletin board for more details and contact information.
