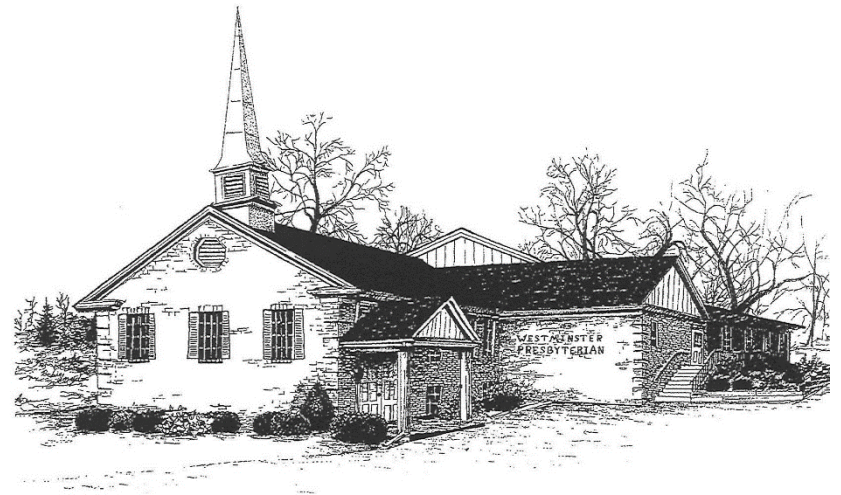
Daytime Fellowship Group will continue to meet at the Raichle's on the *4th Thursday* of each month through the summer.
