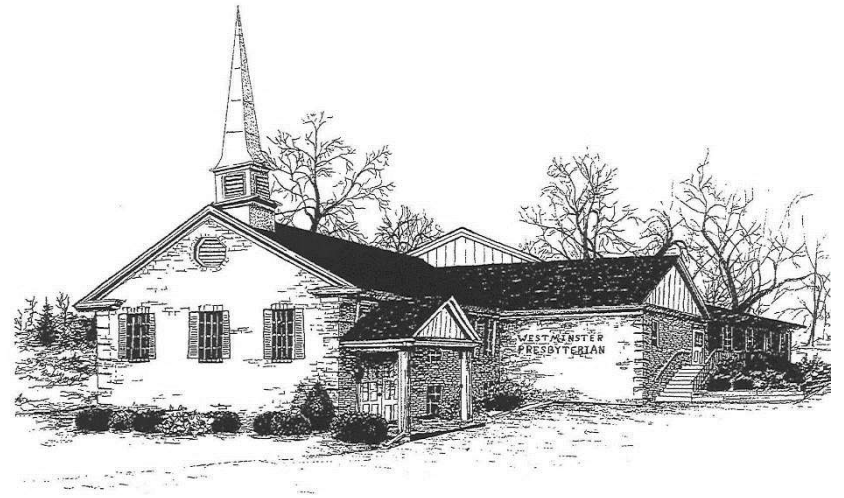
Thanksgiving Week Contrary to the calendar, there will be no fellowship groups meeting on *November 26th or 27th*.
