Leadership Update There will be a brief informational meeting on *Sunday, November 30th* immediately following the morning worship service.

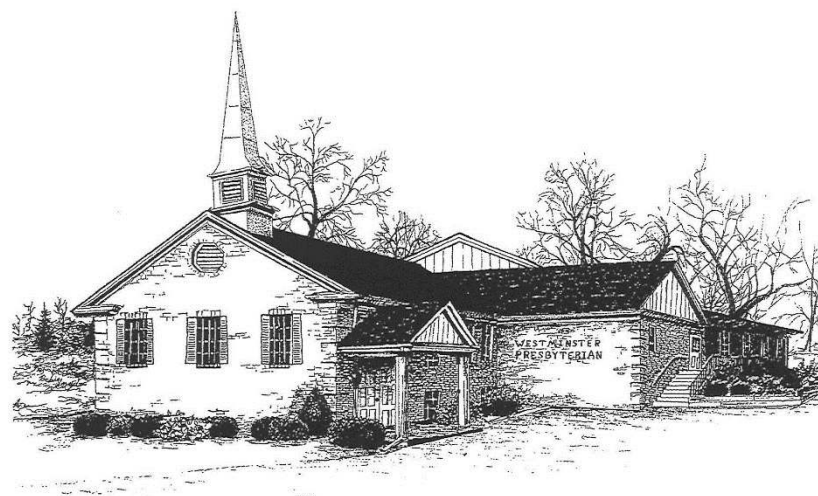
