Diaper Drive During the month of *February* there will be a designated bin in the back foyer for baby diapers (any size) and baby wipes to be given to Precious Life for their ministry.

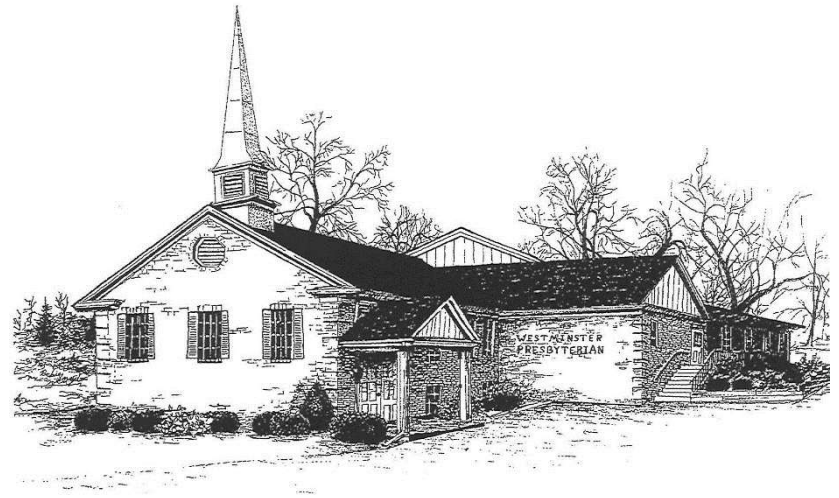
