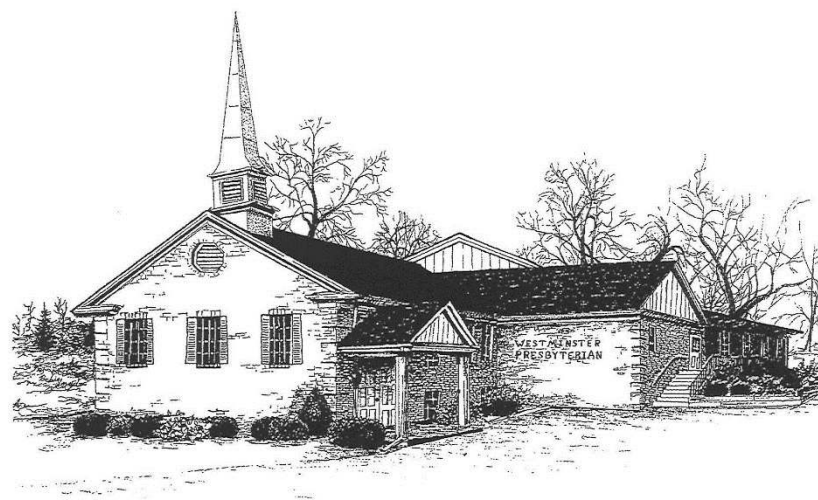
Presbyterian Home Outreach All are welcome to join in worship with the residents at **2:00 PM** *next Sunday, February 15th*.
