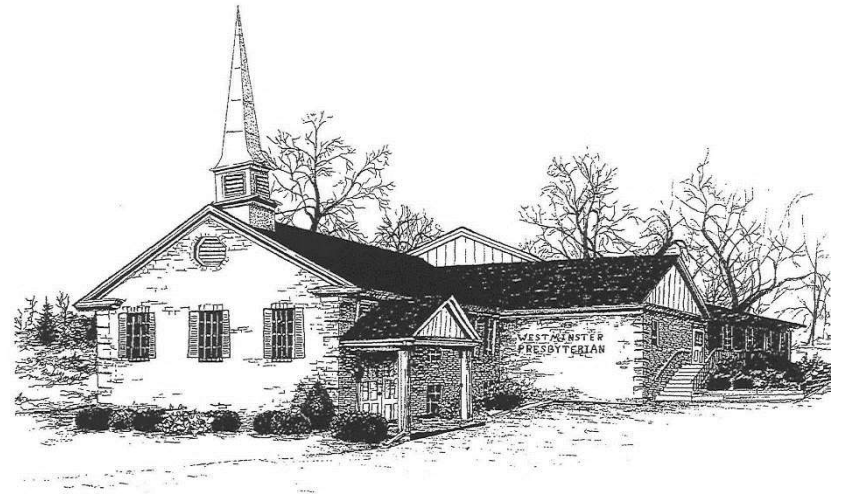
Volunteers Welcome Members are asked to prayerfully consider serving in the following ministries:
