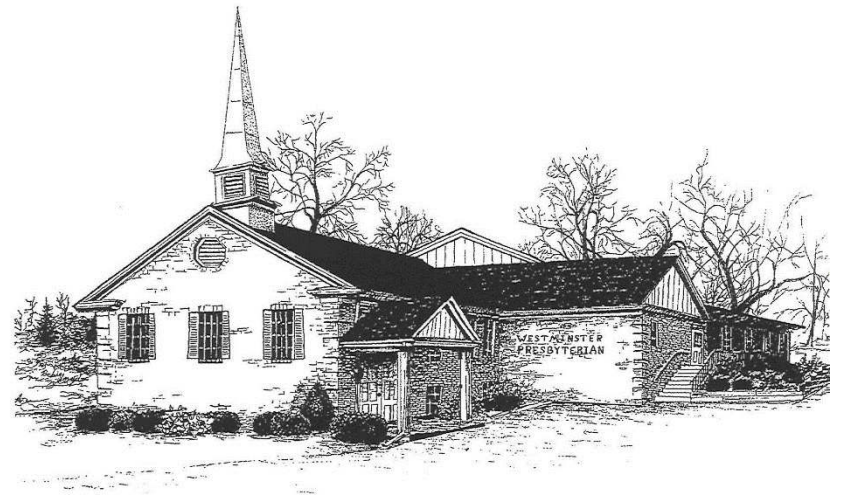
New Member We rejoice that *next Lord's Day morning* we will be welcoming new member Julia Guyer by profession of faith.
