Cookout David Reem invites the Youth Group *and their families* to his home for a meal and fun fellowship *on Saturday, May 23rd* at **5:00 PM**.

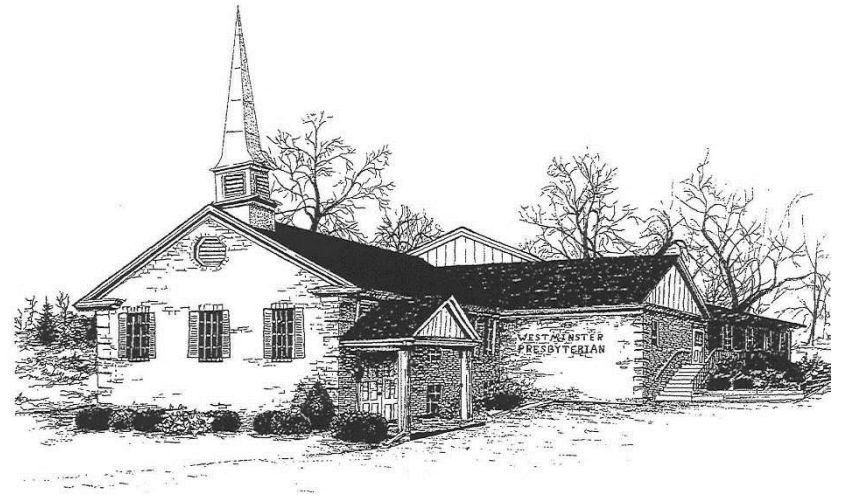
